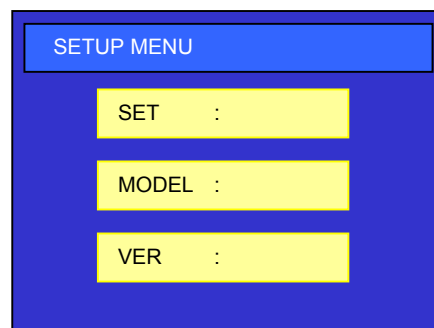

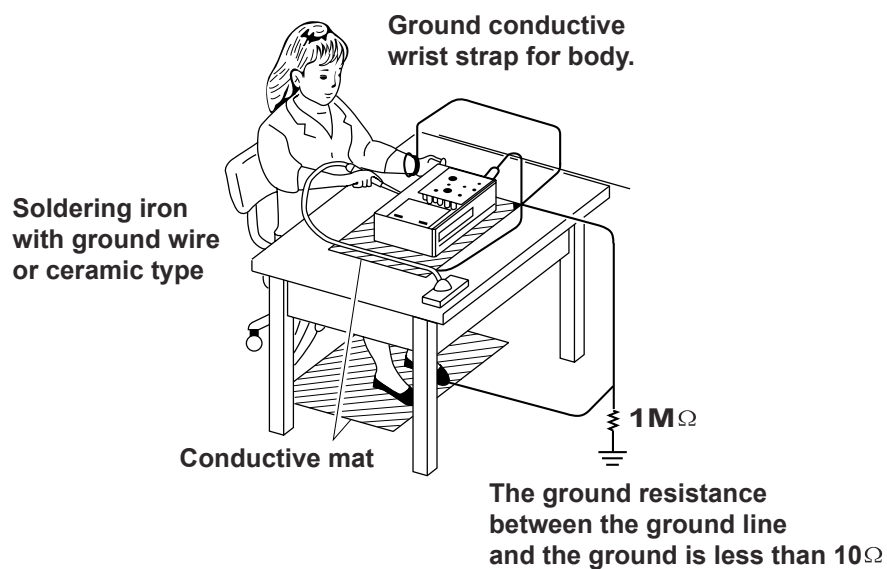

PREPARATION OF SERVICING

Pickup Head consists of a laser diode that is very susceptible to external static electricity.

Although it operates properly after replacement, if it was subject to electrostatic discharge during replacement, its life might be shortened. When replacing, use a conductive mat, soldering iron with ground wire, etc. to protect the laser diode from damage by static electricity.

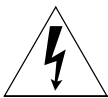
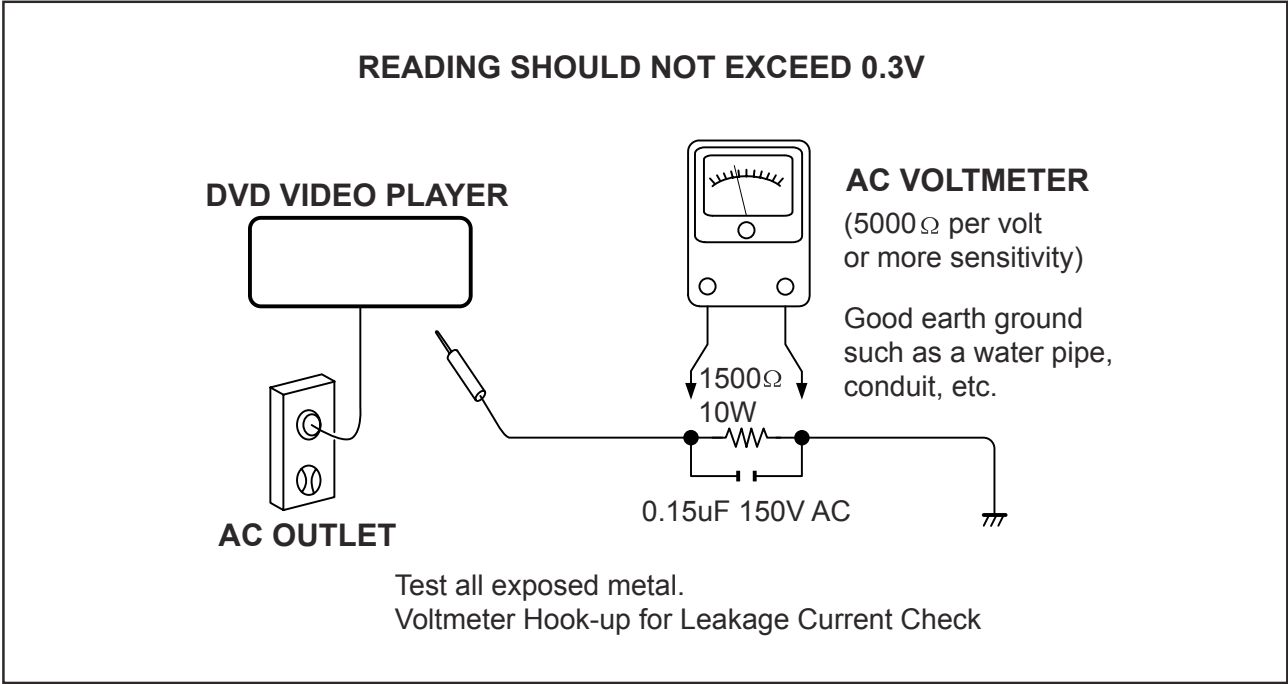

LEAKAGE CURRENT CHECK

Plug the AC line cord directly into a 120V AC outlet (do not use an isolation transformer for this check). Use an AC voltmeter, having 5000 Ω per volt or more sensitivity. Connect a 1500 Ω 10W resistor,paralleled by a 0.15uF 150V AC capacitor between a knomn good earth ground (water pipe, conduit, etc.) and all exposed metal parts of cabinet (antennas, handle bracket, metal cabinet screwheads, metal overlays, control shafts, etc.).

Measure the AC voltage across the 1500 Ω resistor. The test must be conducted with the AC switch on and then repeated with the AC switch off. The AC voltage indicated by the meter may not exceed 0.3V.A reading exceeding 0.3V indicates that a dangerous potential exists, the fault must be located and corrected. Repeat the above test with the DVD VIDEO PLAYER power plug reversed. NEVER RETURN A DVD VIDEO PLAYER TO THE CUSTOMER WITHOUT TAKING NECESSARY CORRECTIVE ACTION.

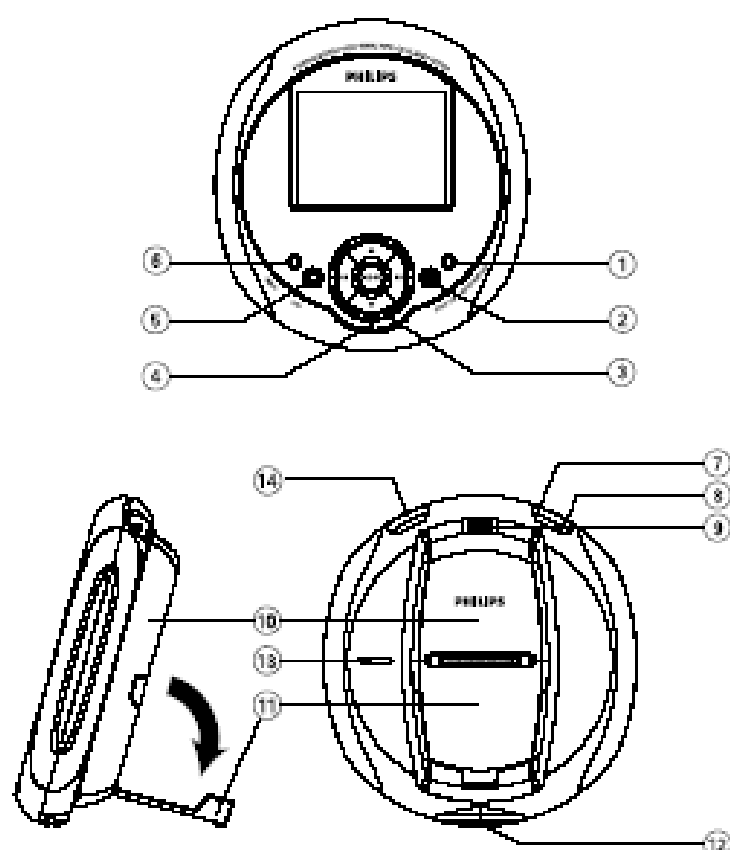

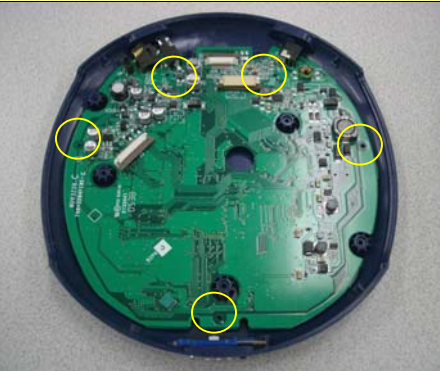
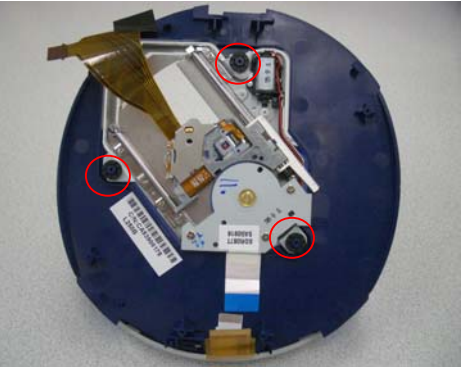
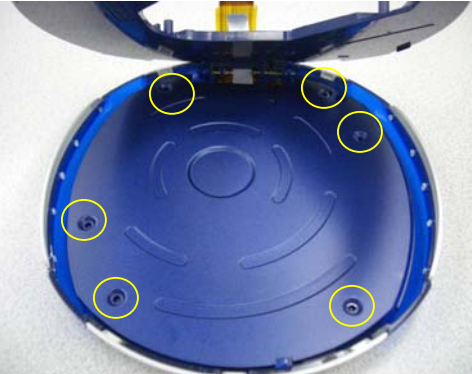
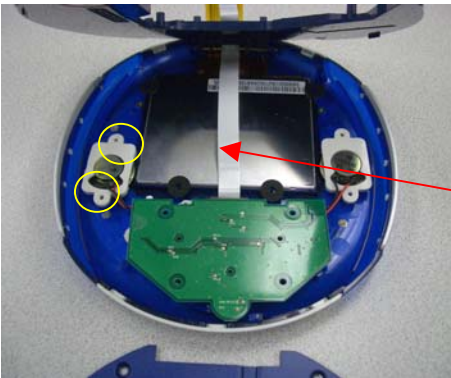


- ① **SETUP / RETURN** ..Enter the SETUP menu. Work as return key in PBC disc.
- ② **■**- Press once to Stop playback.
- Press twice to power off the set
- ③ **Navigation keys**
 - ▶II - OK Play / Pause / OK / Power ON
 - ▲ / ▼ Up / Down cursor or Up / Down Volume control during playback
 - ◀◀ / ▶▶ Left / Right cursor or Previous / Next track or Fast search Backward / Forward
- ④ **LED Indicator Light**....During charging, the LED is RED. When the device is fully charged, the LED is GREEN.
- ⑤ **OSD**Enter the On Screen Display playback function settings
- ⑥ **MENU**Display the DVD disc menu
- ⑦ **Headphone jack** ..For headphone listening
- ⑧ **AV OUT** For TV connection
- ⑨ **Battery Release**....Press to take out the battery pack
- ⑩ **Rechargeable Battery Pack**

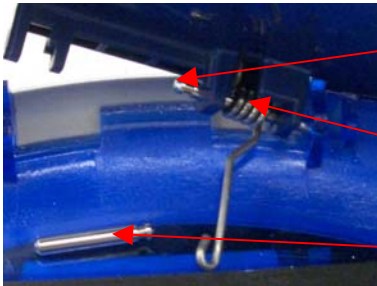

	1 Remove the screws on bottom housing cabinet	
	2 Use finger or treezer to separate middle cabinet from the bottom cabinet assy	
	3 Generally open up the bottom cabinet	
	4 After removal the bottom cabinet, there is the bottom PCBA connected with the bottom cabinet. While another side, there is the driver, LCD and top PCBA connected with the middle and top cabinet.

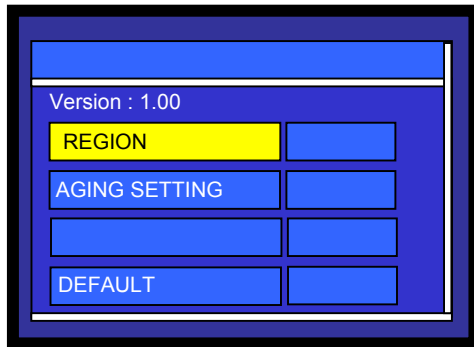

5.1 Procedure to change region code

1. Open DVD Door
2. Press and hold the OSD key together with the POWER ON (▶II) key for about 4sec to enter CONFIGURATION SETUP menu
3. Press the UP and DOWN (▲▼) key to enter REGION on menu

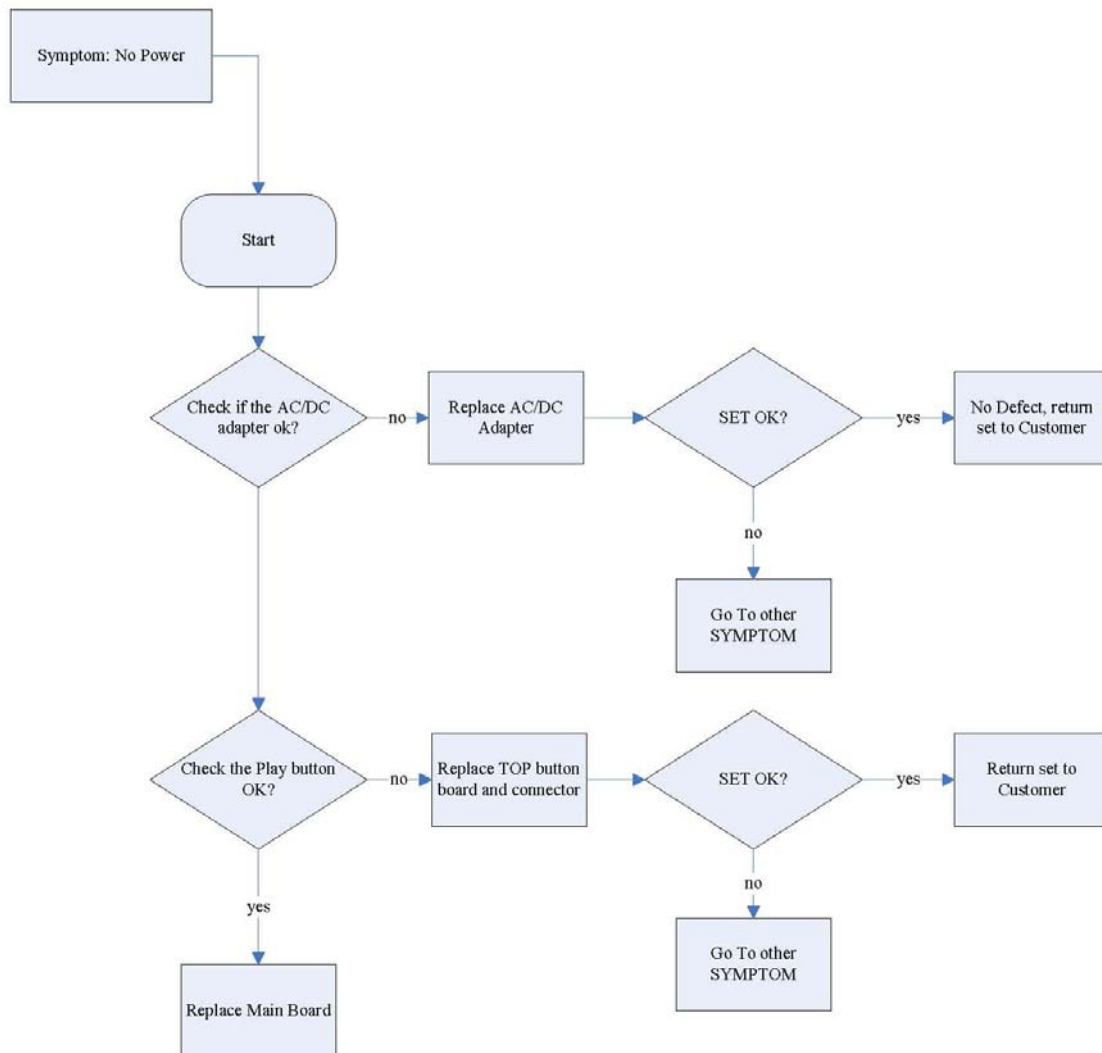


4. Press the NEXT (▶▶|) key to select REGION NO.
5. Press the UP and DOWN (▲▼) key to select number of 1 to 6
6. Press the OK key to save the selection.
Note : Once press OK, data with new REGION NO. will be stored into EEPROM and replace the old one.
7. Switch off and re-switch on the product
8. Verify Region code change done

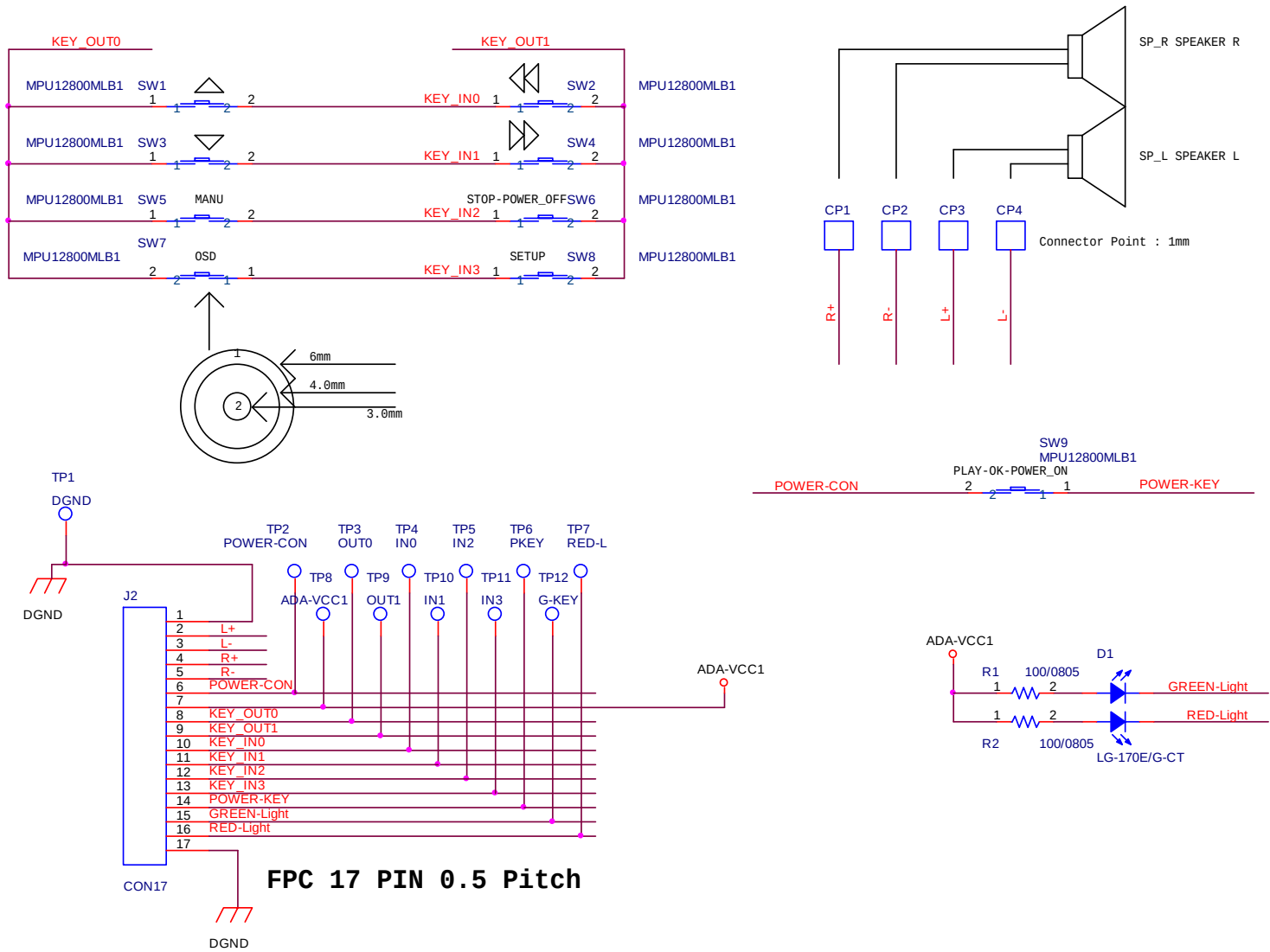


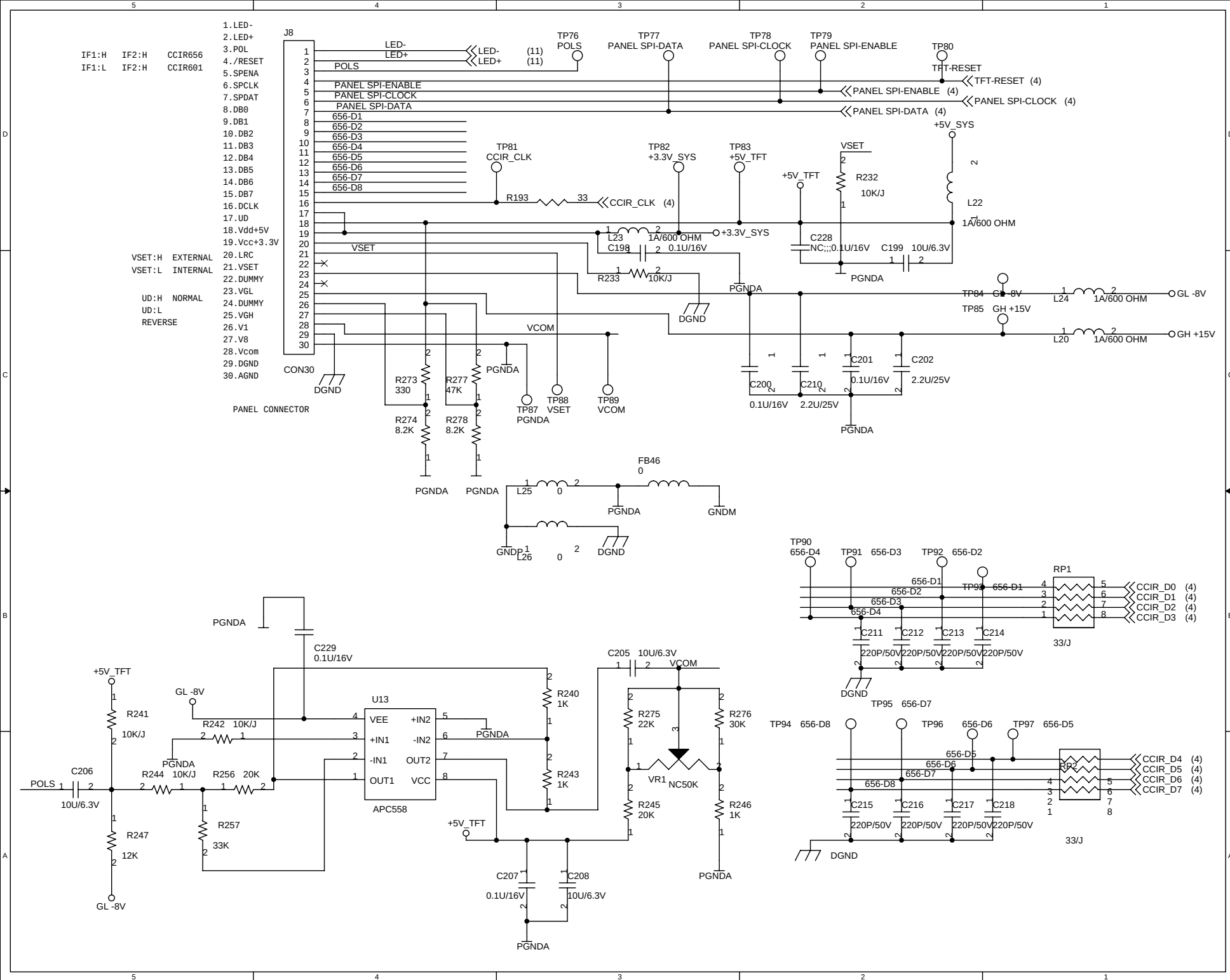
6. OVERALL BLOCK DIAGRAM



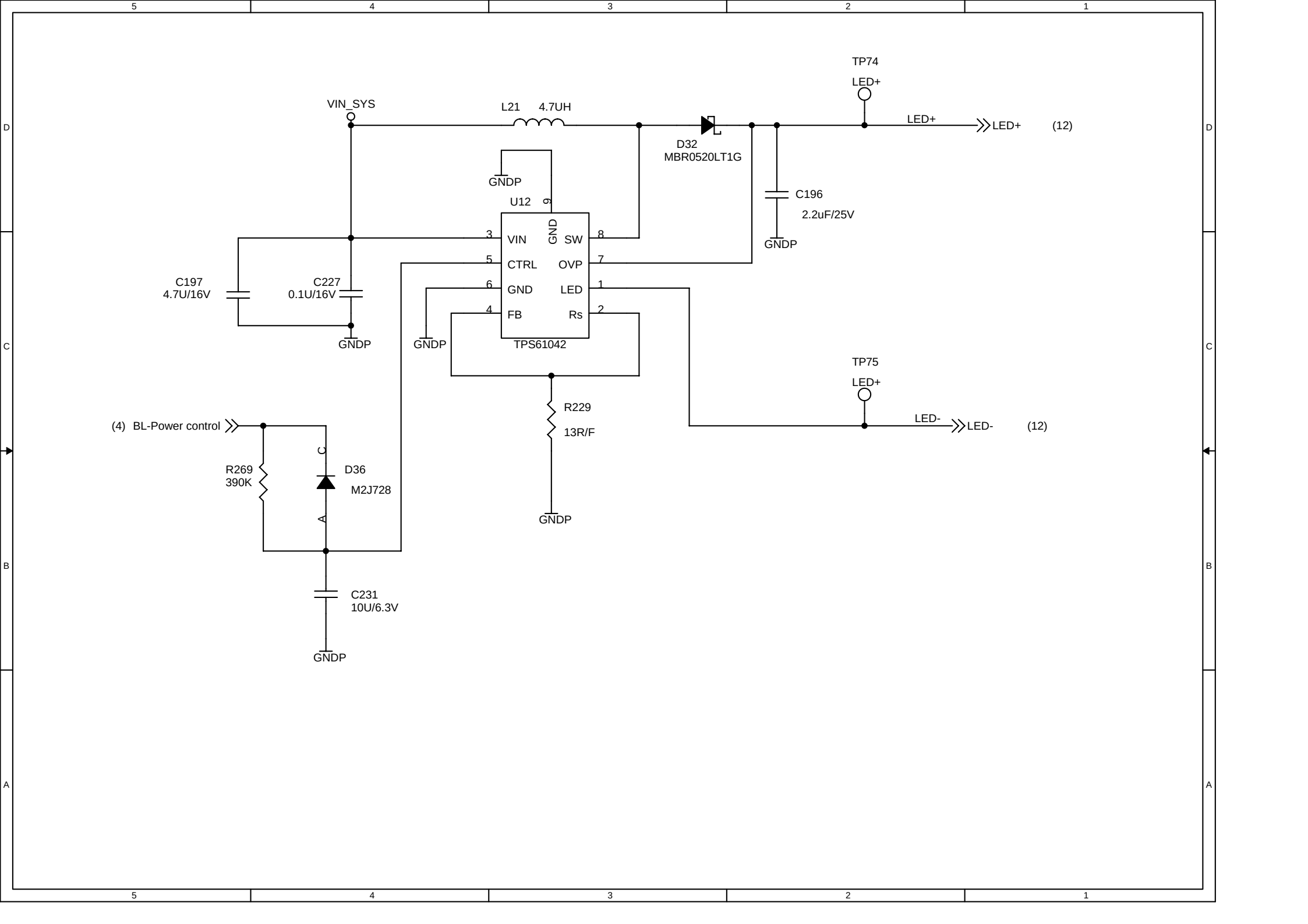

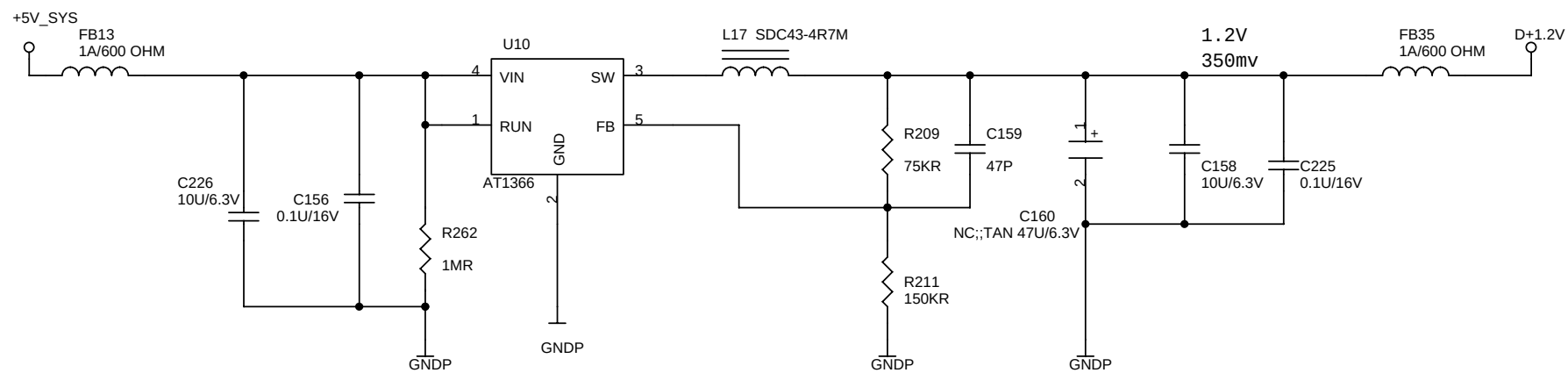
7.1 Electrical Diagram of Top PCBA

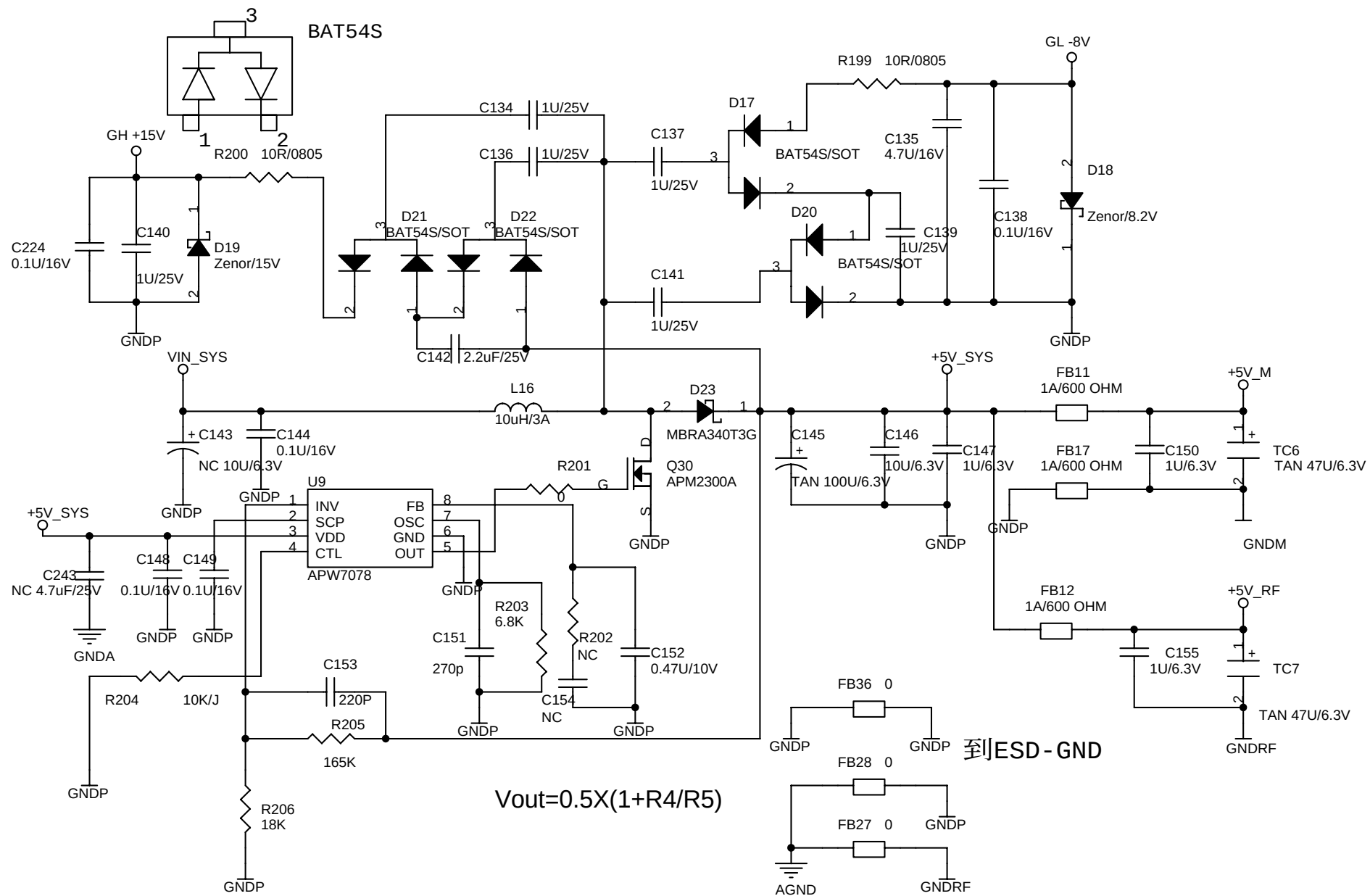


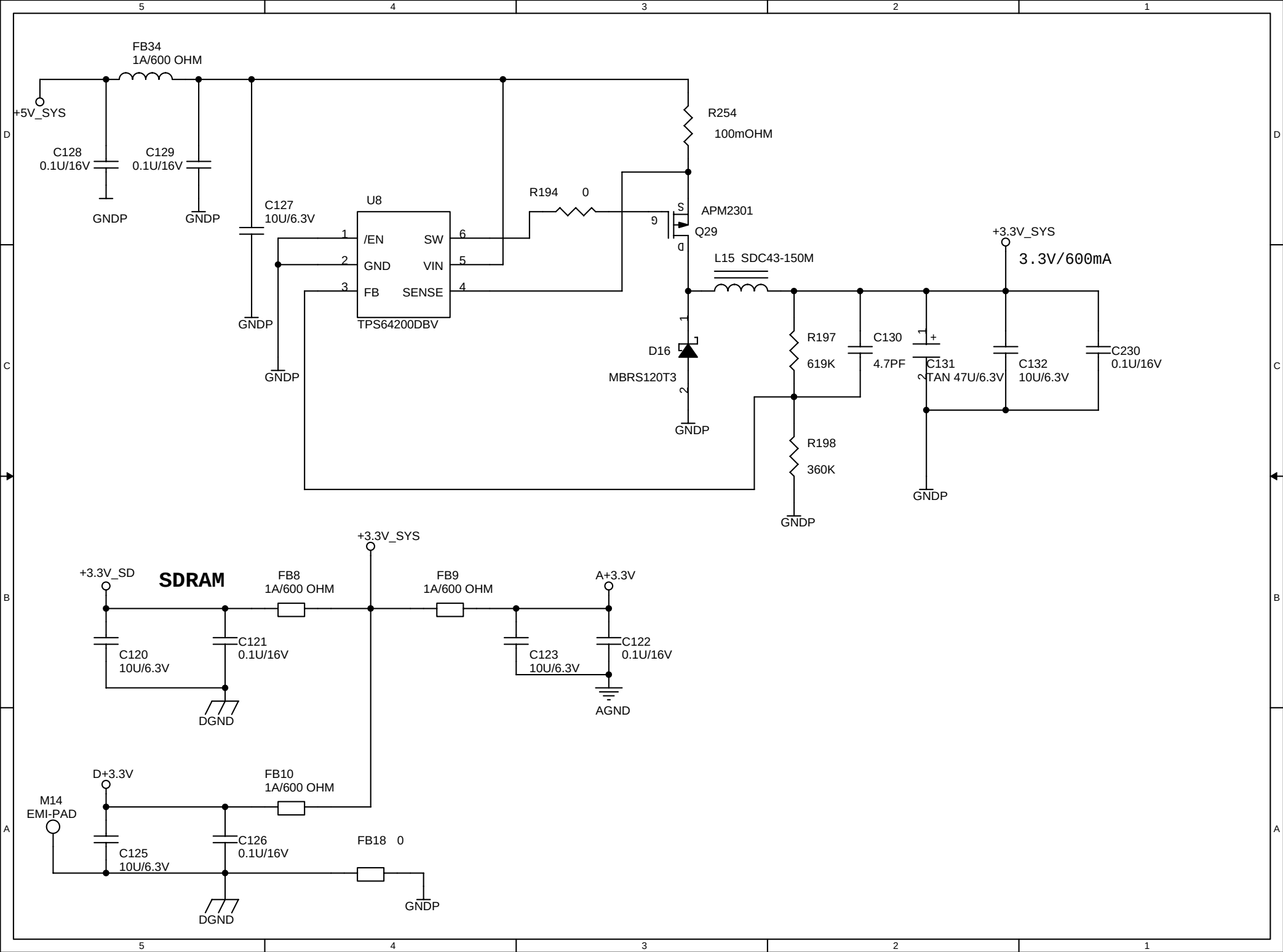


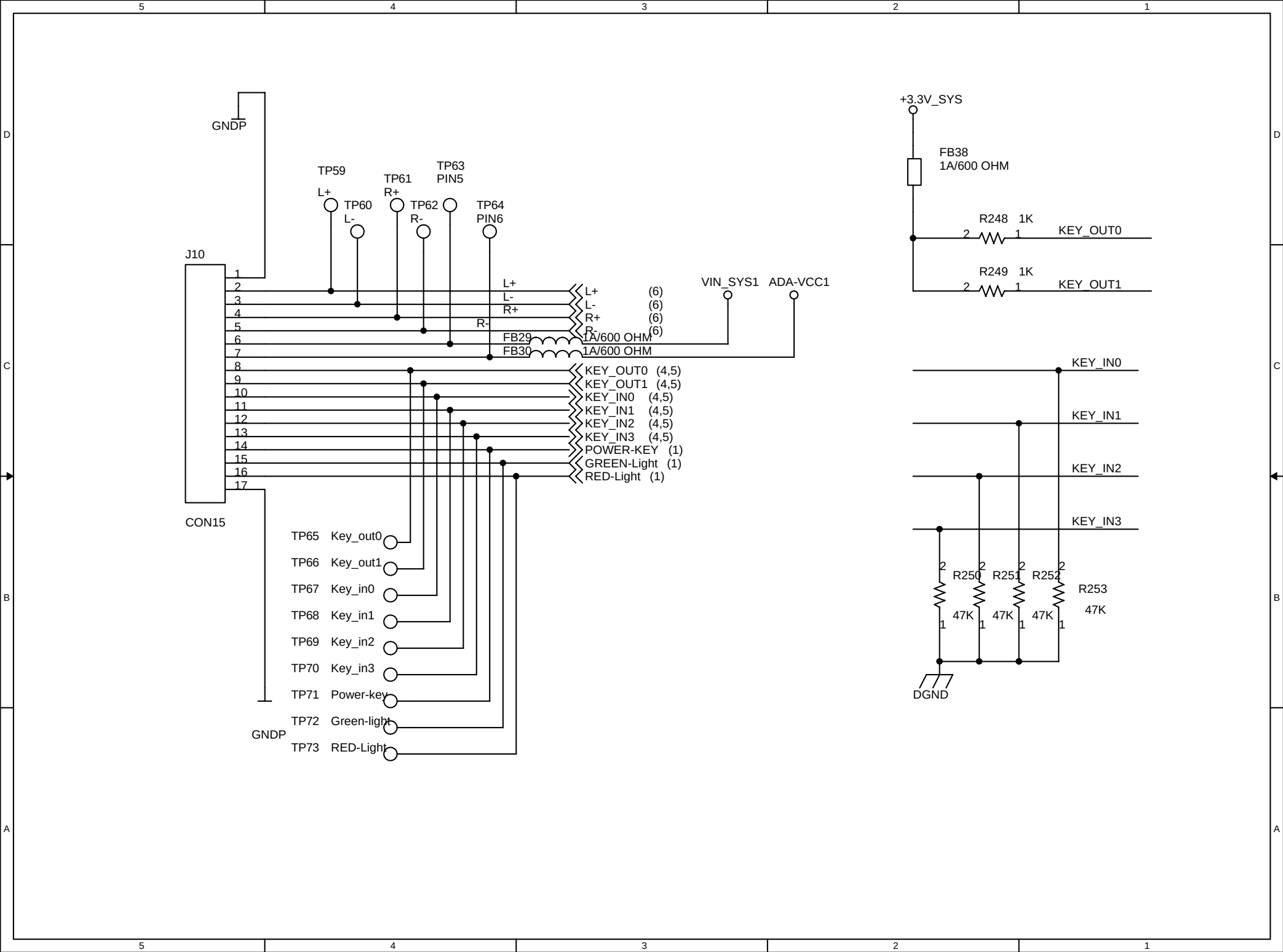
7.2 Electrical Diagram of Bottom PCBA

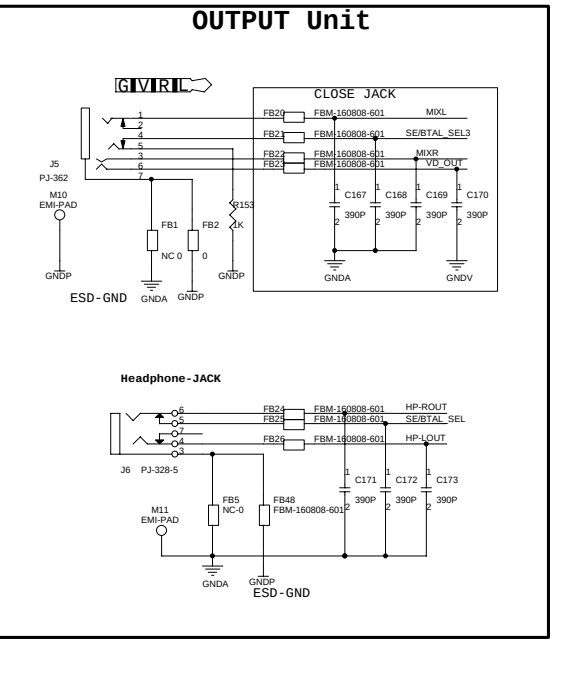
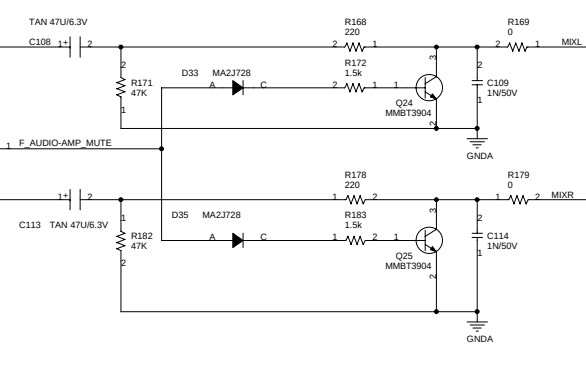
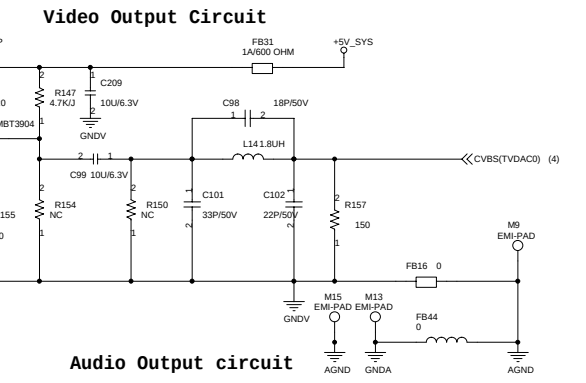
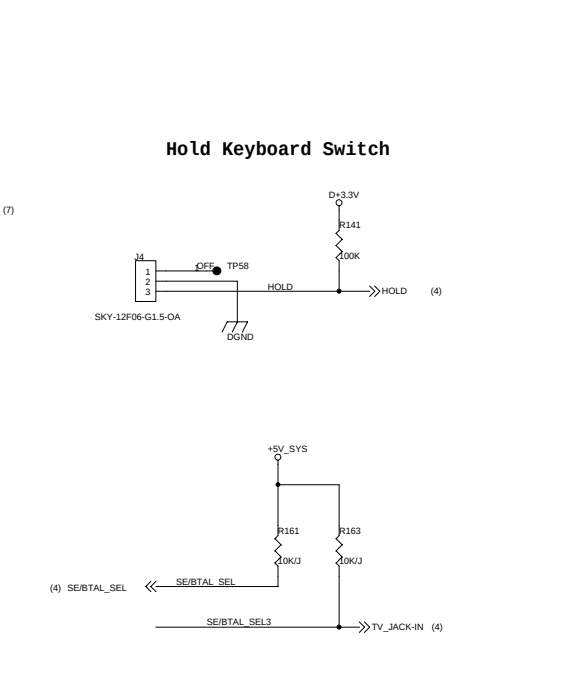
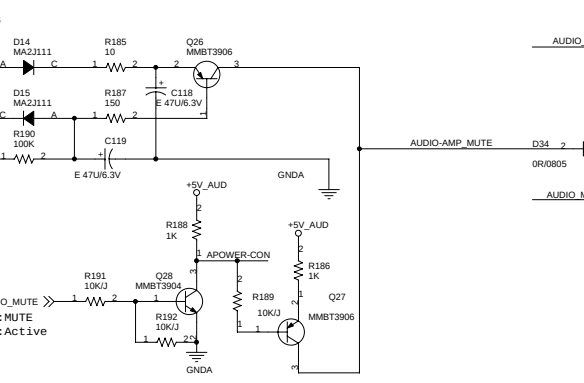
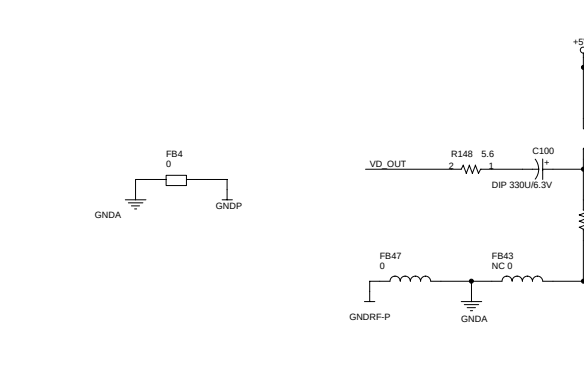
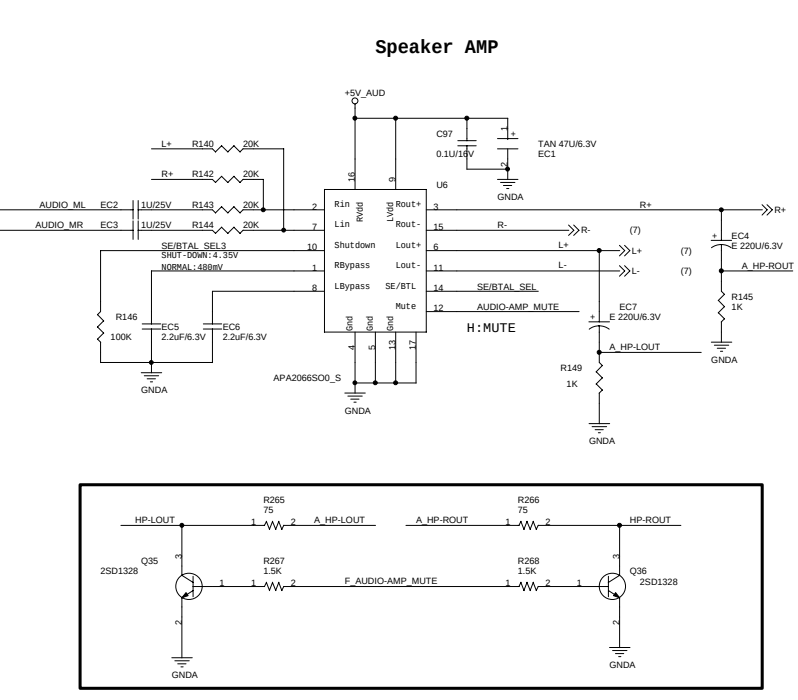
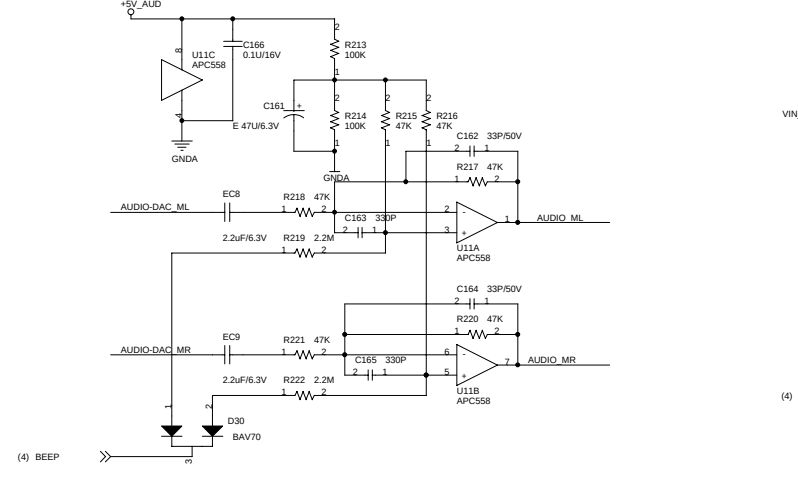
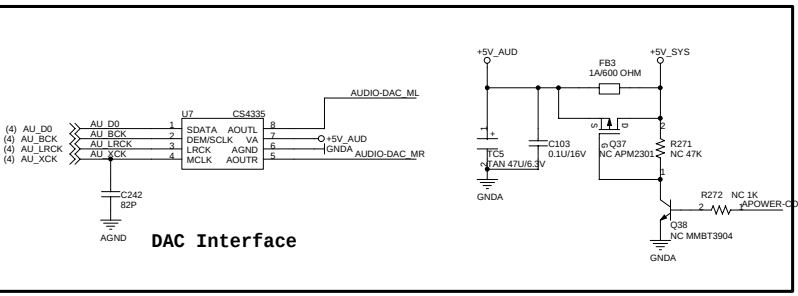


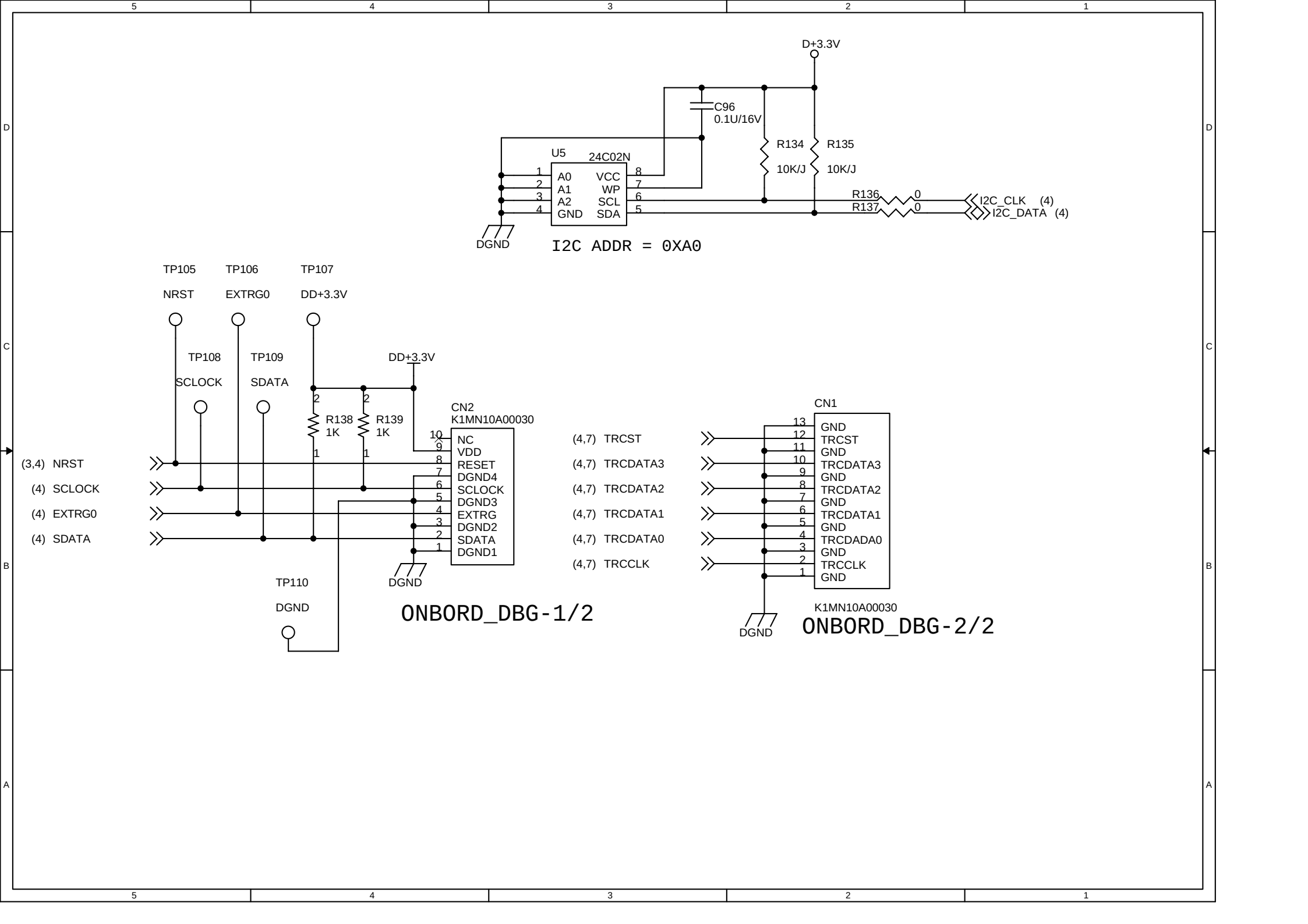


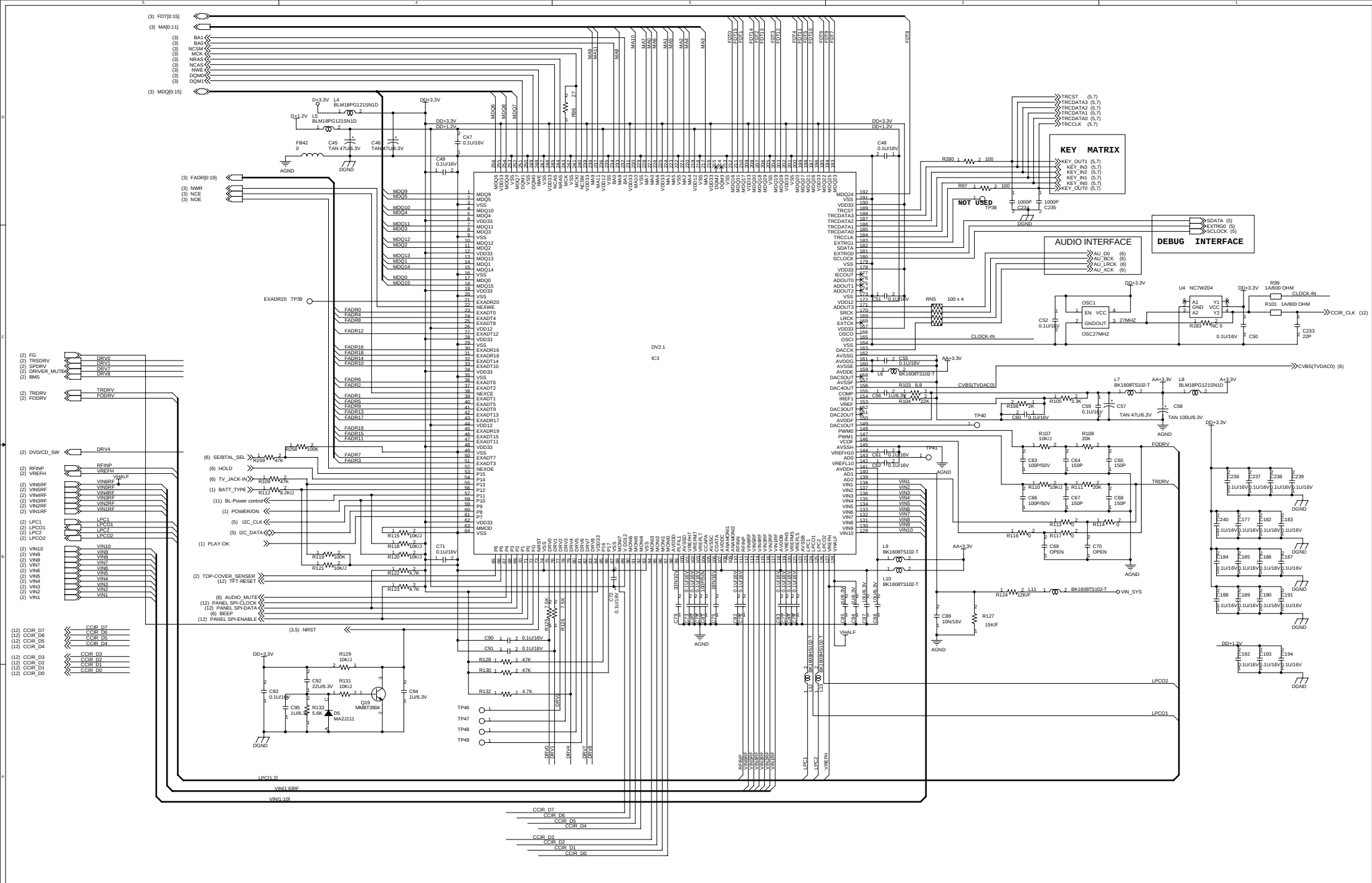


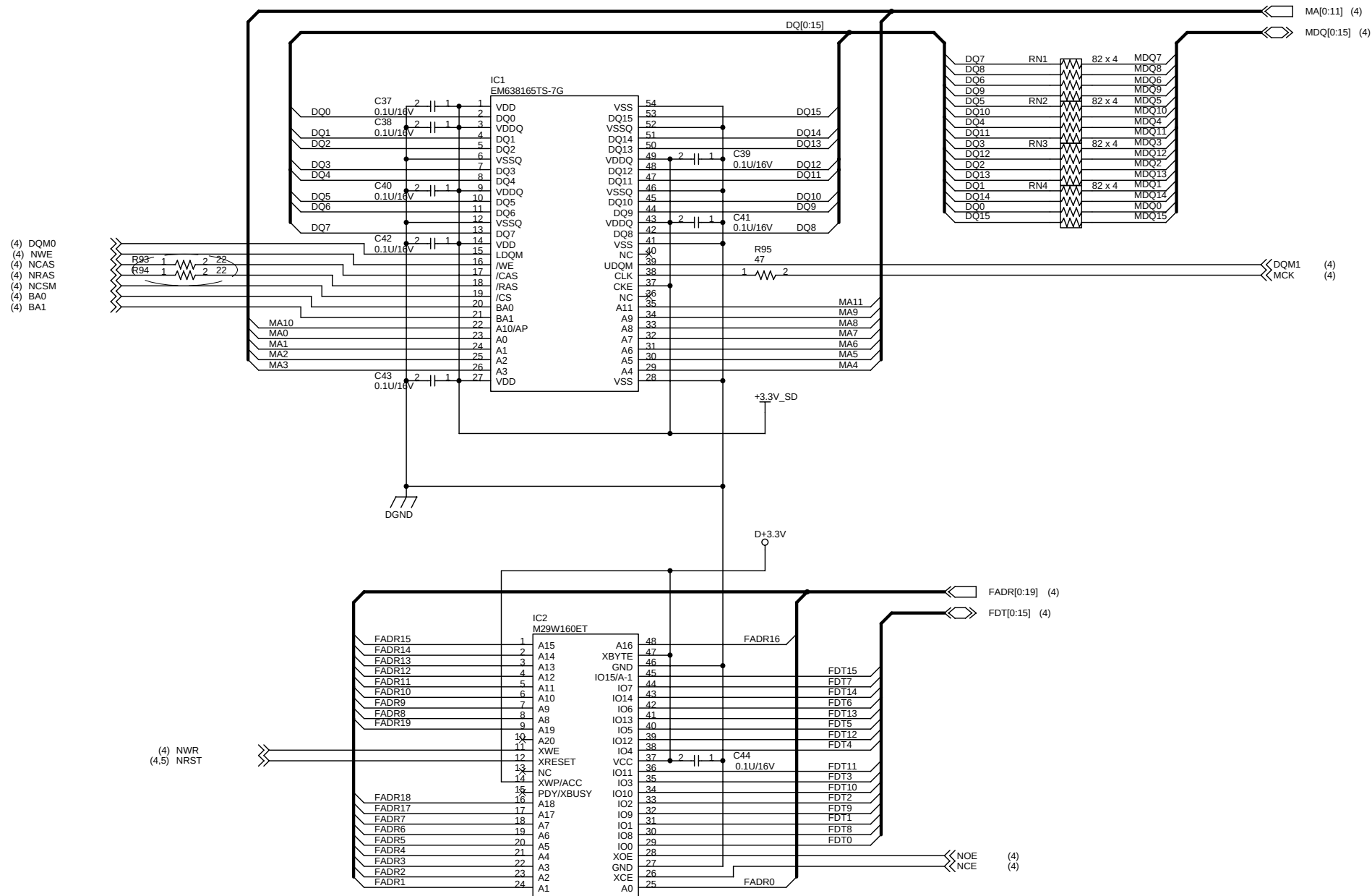






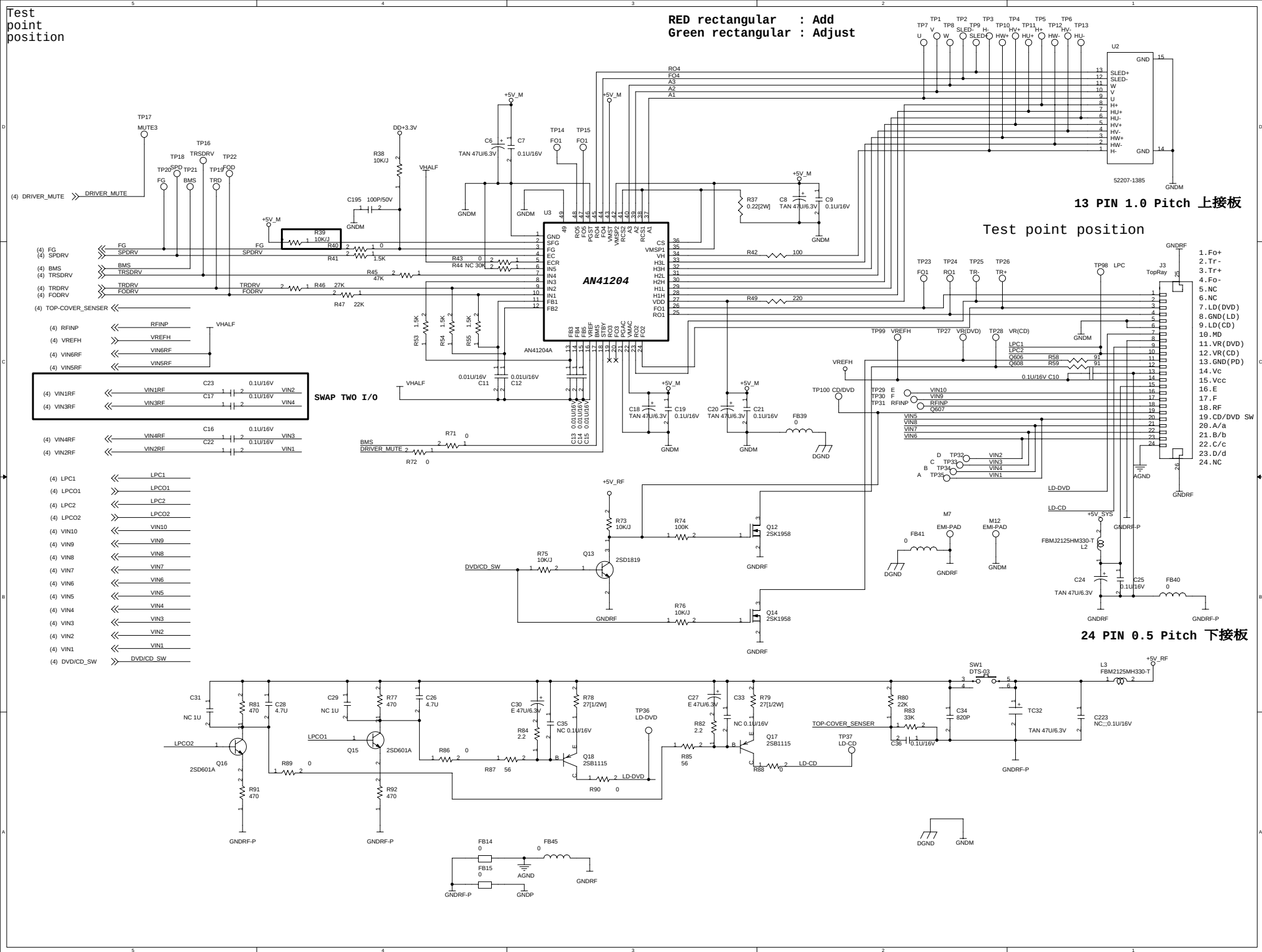


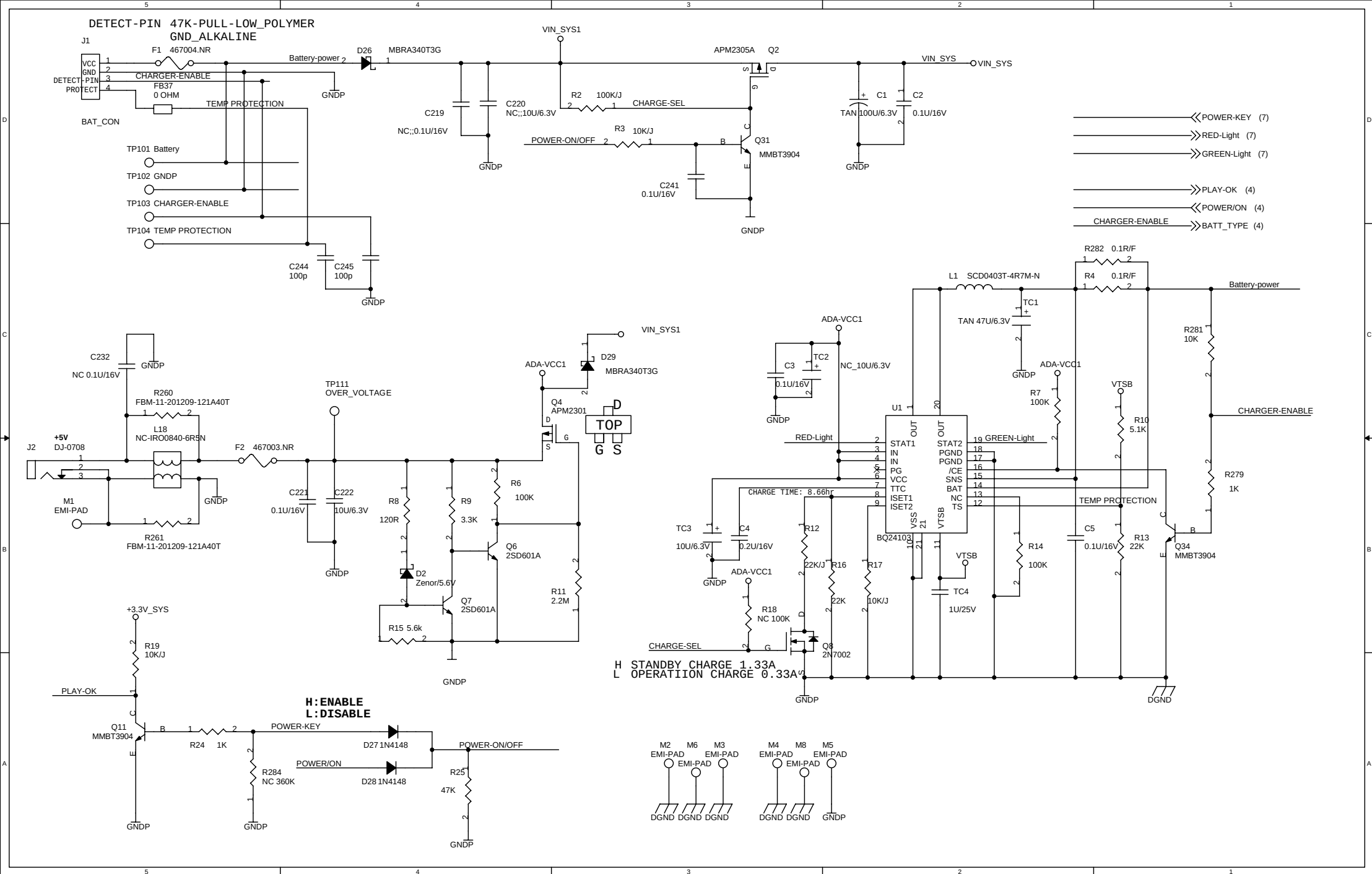

8.1 Component layout of Bottom PCBA



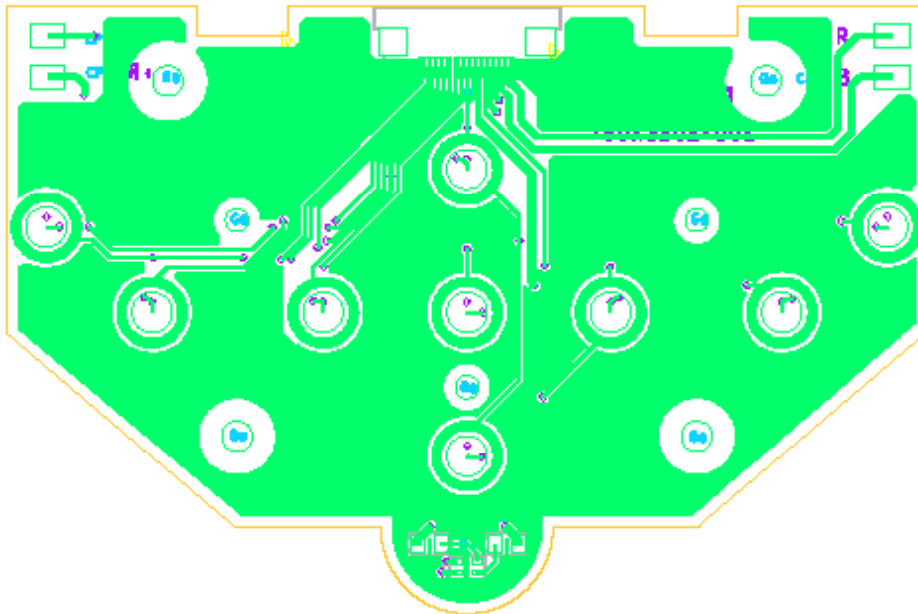

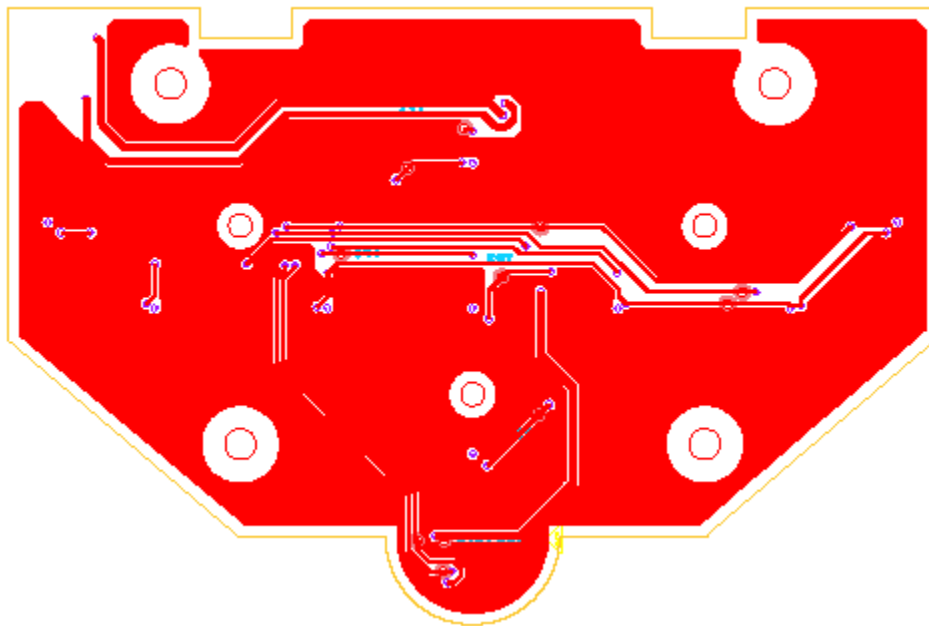

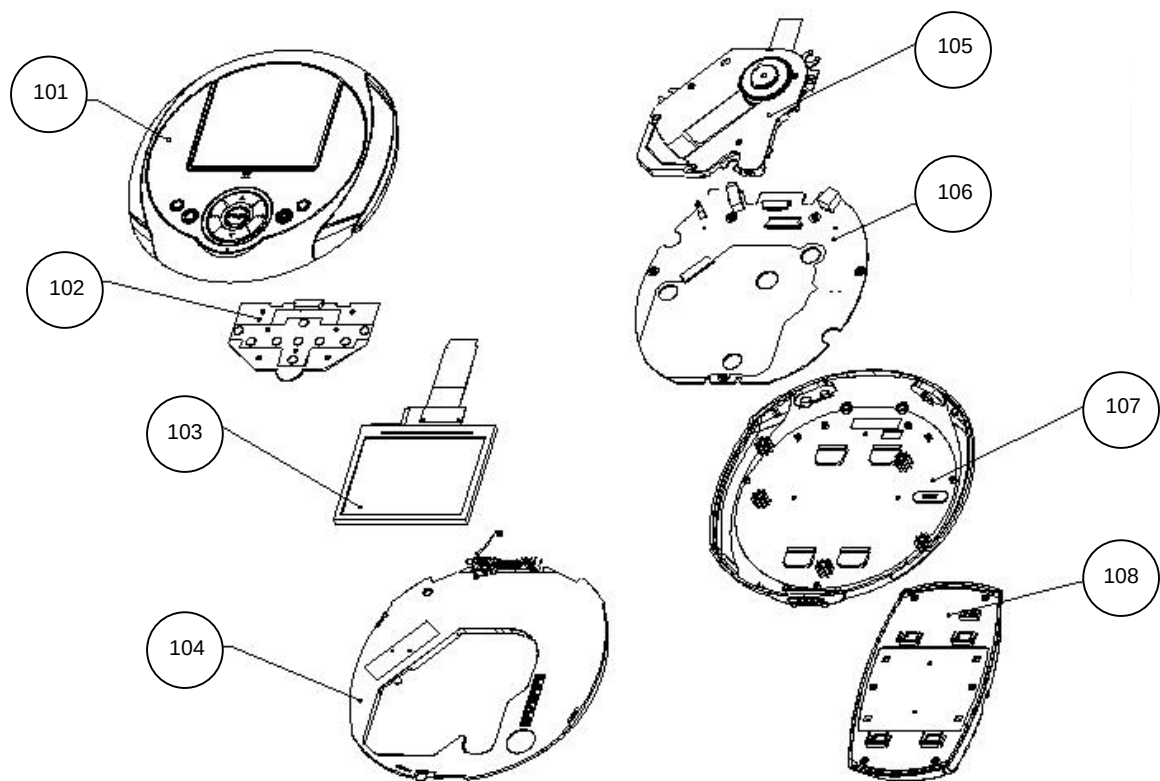
